1. Introduction

Profiler is an application that lets you automate profile switching during the day. You can schedule profiles each day to change from one profile to another. Each profile is set a start and end time, the days which the profile will be active and optionally set to vibrate if the device is in Holster or when the keyboard is locked.

When a profile is set to active it will repeat every day until you manually deactivate or delete the profile.

Optionally you can schedule a temporary profile from the Calendar application. Temporary profile only active for the current day and it does not repeat.

2. System Requirement

- BlackBerry® OS 4.2 and higher
- 40K of free main memory.

2.1 Compatibility

- BlackBerry® Pearl, Curve, Bold, 8700 series and 8800 series
- BlackBerry® Profile application

3. Installation

3.1 OTA Installation

If you have data connection you can install Profiler using the BlackBerry® Browser application.

1. Start the Browser application
2. Select GoTo from the menu
3. Enter www.toysoft.ca/ota/Profiler.jad
4. Press ENTER to start the download

3.2 Application Loader Installation

On your desktop computer do the following:

1. Start the BlackBerry® Desktop Manager
2. Double click on the Application Loader icon
3. Click Next
4. Click on the Add button
5. Browse for the file Profiler.alx in the Profiler folder where you unzipped the file.
6. Click Next to install

4. Launching Profiler

To launch Profiler, look for the icon  on the Home screen and click on it.

5. Registering Profiler After You Have Purchased Profiler

After you have installed Profiler, launch Profiler and you will see the following screen below.

Your registration code is included in the invoice email that you have received. Enter the code in Registration Code field and click the **Register** button. You will only have to do this once.

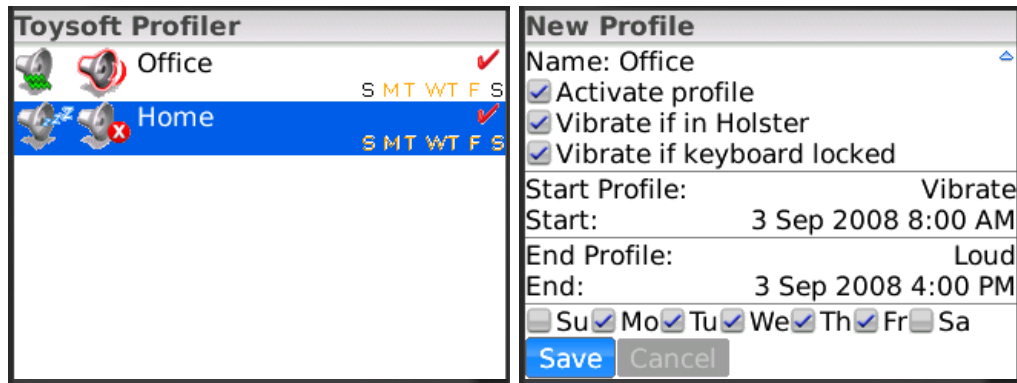

To purchase Profiler using your BlackBerry® you can click on the Purchase button. For a 10 day trial click on the Trial Mode button.

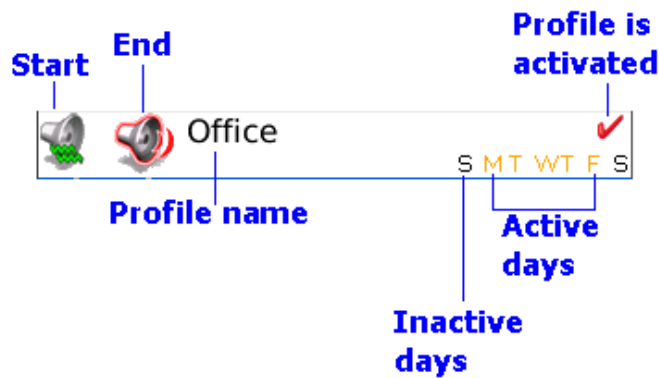
6. User Interface

To add a New, Edit or Delete a Profile press the Menu key. All of your Profiles will be displayed on the main screen.



7. Edit Profile

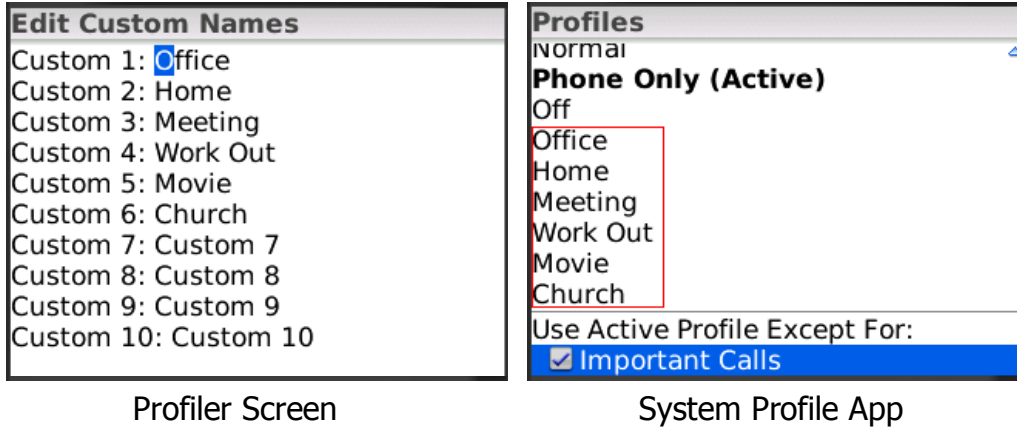

Profile must be set to Activate before it will work. When the profile is triggered Profiler will automatically adjust the date to the next day. This will repeat until you deactivate or delete the profile.

Once you have a profile defined you do not need to change it unless you want to change the time or deactivate it.

| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Vibrate if keyboard locked | If your Blackberry's keyboard is locked then you can check to have Profiler vibrate so that you unlock it and have Profile activate the new profile. This is a workaround for the RIM security when the keyboard is locked. |
| Start Profile: Vibrate | This is the start profile to be activated when the scheduled profile is triggered. |
| Start: 3 Sep 2008 8:00 AM | The starting time for the scheduled profile to be activated. |
| End Profile: Loud | This is the end profile to be activated when the scheduled profile is triggered. |
| End: 3 Sep 2008 4:00 PM | The ending time for the scheduled profile to be activated. |

8. Editing Custom Names



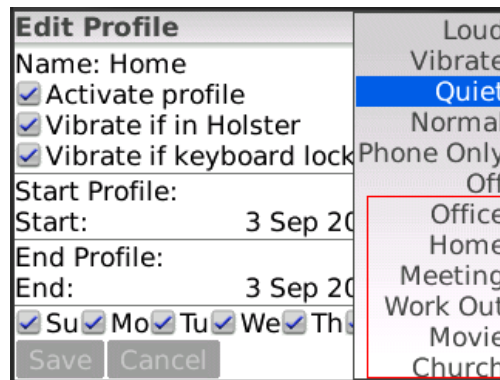

System Profile App

Since Profiler cannot interface with the system Profile application the work around for custom profiles is to edit the custom names to match the Profile application.

There are 10 custom names in Profiler that you can edit. Custom 1 should be the first custom profile name in the system Profile application, Custom 2 is the second and so on.

Custom profiles start from the Off profile in the system Profiles application.



When you create or edit a profile you will see the custom profile names.

9. Setting Application Permissions

Proper permission must be enabled for Profiler to work correctly. To edit permission do the following and set all permissions to ALLOW

1. Run the Options application on the Home screen
2. Select Advanced Options
3. Select Applications
4. Select Profiler
5. Press the Menu key and select Edit Permissions
6. Set all Permissions to ALLOW

9.1 Known Issues

1. When the device is in the Holster Profiler cannot switch the Profile until you take it out.
2. When the keyboard is locked Profiler cannot switch the Profile until you unlock it.

The Calendar Keywords screen allows you to setup keywords so that you can easily enter the Keyword in the Calendar application to set a pre-defined profile.

Keywords can be any work or phrase. Just make sure it is unique so that it will not be triggered when you enter a common subject for the appointment.

Calendar profiles are active for the current day only and it does not work for future appointments.

Once you have setup all the keywords you can then go to the Calendar and create a new appointment and type in the keyword. Once you have added an appointment you can go back to Profiler and select View Temp Profiles from the menu. You can also clear all the temp profiles in the menu.

11. Calendar Integration

There are two ways you can enter a profile in the Calendar application. Both methods requires to you create a new appointment.

Calendar profiles are only active for the current day and you cannot schedule profiles for future appointments.

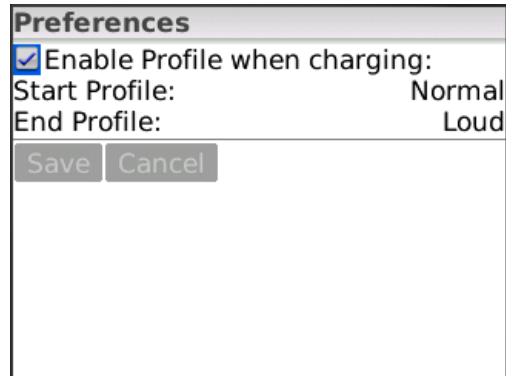
11.1 Method 1

- 1 Run the Calendar application
- 2 Press the Menu key on the keyboard
- 3 Select the New menu item
- 4 Press the Menu key on the keyboard
- 5 Select New Profile... menu item to set a profile
- 6 Select the Start and End profiles
- 7 Select Save button
- 8 Do not change the text that Profiler displays in the Subject: label
- 9 Set the start and end time for your appointment and save it
- 10 To view the temporary profile run Profiler and select View Temp Profiles from the menu

11.2 Method 2

- 1 Run the Calendar application
- 2 Select the appointment time for Today
- 3 Type in a keyword that you have assigned in Profiler Calendar Keyword setup screen
- 4 To view the temporary profile run Profiler and select View Temp Profiles from the menu

12. Preferences



You can assign a start and end profiles when the BlackBerry is charging. The charging profile is not 100% compatible with USB charger however it will work with the wall mounted chargers.

2. Select Advanced Options
3. Select Applications
4. Select Profiler
5. Press the Menu key and select Delete
